

**Macungie Memorial Park  
Board Meeting Minutes  
February 26, 2019  
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**Call to Order:** Alan Printz called the meeting to order. Advised the meeting is being recorded.

**Board Attendance:** Alan Printz, Kevin Wieder, Fred Wieder, Mike Delong. Not in attendance: Brian Nagle, Donald Young.

**Visitors:** No Visitor concerns.

**Review of Minutes:** Fred Wieder made motion to approve the minutes. Kevin Wieder second. Motion approved.

**Correspondence:** Amy Hillegass reported that \$150 donation was received from Jacqueline Leipter. Donation was placed into endowment fund.

**Building and Grounds Technician:** Report provided for review.

Gary Arndt advised that building of handicap bathroom in Memorial Hall is in process. Thank you to Fred Wieder, John Hartzell and Jeff Erb for the help with building the bathroom. Someone will be coming to give suggestions for covering the exterior of bathroom at the front of Memorial Hall.

Plans are in the works for completing electric upgrade based on Tourism Grant awarded through DCED.

**Treasurer Report:** Financial reports provided for review. Current balance in savings account is \$47,767. Mike Delong made motion to accept Treasurer's Report, Kevin Wieder second. Motion approved.

**Fescht Report:** Amy reported that as of February 26, 2019 there are 686 vehicles and 189 flea market spaces registered.

Following up with insurance agent about possible requirements for corralling areas where selling and consuming alcohol during Fescht. Following up with beer vendors for selling during Fescht.

Vote taken to continue providing fireworks entertainment during Fescht. Majority ruled. Deposit will be sent to Celebration Fireworks for 2019 show.

**Pool Report:** Alice was not in attendance.

Amy reported that Alice stated she had communication with employees for 2019 season, is working on scheduling a meeting to provide paperwork and discuss responsibilities.

**Manager's Report:** Had meeting with Coke representatives. Effective June 1 there will be 3% price increase to all Coke product purchased. Plan is to order bulk amount of water and some soda flavors before price increase. The Park's sale price to public per water bottle and soda can will not increase for 2019 season, will be increased for 2020 season.

Working on review of Lehigh County Community Development Block Grant for possibility of being awarded dollars to convert pool outside bathrooms to handicap.

Working on soliciting sponsors and gathering information for annual bulk newsletter which is mailed early April. A volunteer has offered to review macungiepark.com for options available for upgrade and to make additions to our website using the current website host. Thought is for the future newsletter information to be on new website instead of bulk mailing. Upgrading the website to have ability to offer pool memberships purchases, rental booking, etc. through macungiepark.com.

Had discussion with Phil Kresge regarding Lions Club providing general donation toward the building of handicap bathrooms.

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Egg hunt is in the planning process. Mike DeLong has offered to help with soliciting for donations and planning the event. Help is needed for future years of coordinating, if interested in continuing 74 year history of egg painting and Easter Sunday egg hunt.

**Tennis Report:** No report provided.

**Old Business:** Mountain Creek maintenance planning discussions.  
Daniel Lenig requested a monument to his late wife be placed by the Walnut Street entrance.

**New Business:** Farmer's Market will be financially supported by Borough for 2019 season since it is not currently an established business.  
Alan Printz reported that weekly Farmer's Market will start May 16 with time of 4pm to 7pm. Picnic tables will not be provided by the Park.
