

**Macungie Memorial Park  
Board Meeting Minutes  
March 26, 2019  
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**Call to Order:** Alan Printz called the meeting to order. Advised the meeting is being recorded.

**Board Attendance:** Alan Printz, Kevin Wieder, Brian Nagle, Fred Wieder, Mike DeLong.

Not in attendance: Donald Young.

**Visitors:** Megan Shucavage, representing Macungie Bears Swim Team advised that the team has been growing with returning families. Season starts at the end of May. Evening practices start just after Memorial Day, then morning practice after kids are out of school. Swim meets are 2 times per week, finishing the season about mid July. In 2018 the team placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in championships which was first year for the accomplished record. Various family events happen throughout the season to support the team and coaches. Brandon Mazepa is returning as head coach. Currently there are about 30 kids signed up, there will be an introduction event time at Emmaus High School pool which usually brings about 50 kids to sign up for the team.

**Review of Minutes:** Mike DeLong made motion to approve the minutes. Kevin Wieder second. Brian Nagle abstained. Motion approved.

**Building and Grounds Technician:** Report provided for review.

Gary Arndt stated there were some logs pulled from Mountain Creek area. They are laying near Lehigh Street entrance, anyone can have.

Handicap bathroom in Memorial Hall is in process. Majority completed, other than trim, etc. Thank you to Fred Wieder, John Hartzell, Jeff Erb and Chris Becker for the help with building the bathroom.

**Treasurer Report:** Financial reports provided for review. Current balance in savings account is \$46,401. Fred Wider made motion to accept Treasurer's Report, Brian Nagle second. Motion approved.

**Fesch Report:** Amy reported that as of March 25, 2019 there are 727 vehicles and 202 flea market spaces registered.

Had meeting with Barb Levinson, who is stepping down as Children's Entertainment Coordinator and Sheri Krissinger who is stepping in to fill the position.

Mike DeLong advised he and Amy met with representatives of New Tripoli Bank regarding future sponsorship options for Fesch and Park Newsletter.

Alan Printz advised that for bbq cookoff he is working on a people's choice competition to involve the public in taste testing. Hoping for additional competitors and having the new electric supply to help with set up and tear down. He advised that Ontelaunee members are also working on bringing in a variety of different clubs for different attractions.

Communication came from our insurance agent at Yurconic stating that we are not required to fence in an area for people to stay to drink beer and wine purchased from our vendors. Have been communicating with a local winery to be vendor selling wine.

**Pool Report:** Alice was not in attendance.

Amy reported that pool season membership applications have been coming in.

First payment for chlorine pre-season purchase is approximately \$4,700 due in next few weeks.

Paperwork for employees to complete was given to Alice.

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**Manager's Report:** Amy reported that a workman's compensation claim was filed for an injury Gary Arndt got March 13 while working on building of new bathroom. Injury was a large splinter going under thumb nail of left hand.

Thank you to Mike DeLong who has been assisting with egg hunt planning by soliciting sponsors and donors. Meeting is scheduled with new representatives of Macungie Farmer's Market to discuss placement, layout, etc. Bailey and Associates was contacted to give option of providing quote for all insurance coverages for the Park. Got e-mail notice that enrollment opportunity is open for Lehigh County Tourism Grant, deadline for application is May 10, 2019.

Park is participating in Great American Clean Up on April 16. Local Boy Scout and Cub Scout Troop will be doing clean up at various places around town, then come to the Park to assist with clean up in the Park. Volunteers are needed. Current plan is for basic clean up and dress up of flower beds and grounds area.

Minor changes are being made to weekly bingo games. Players will not have option of using hard board bingo cards, all games played on paper bingo sheets. An experienced caller has offered to do Saturday night bingo calling. Norm will fill in as a caller when needed, continue to order supplies and work floor when not calling.

**Tennis Report:** No report provided.

**Old Business:** Alan Printz advised that request to place angel statue at the Walnut Street entrance has not been approved. Memorials can be either selected tree or bench.

**New Business:** Diane A. advised volunteers are needed.

Brian Nagle opened discussion regarding age requirement for volunteers. Final determination is that a volunteer will not be declined due to age.
